Commission on Aging Update

- Maureen Henry presented on Commission on Aging activities including:
 - Diagram showing the Commission on Aging Special Committees and Work Groups
 - o Update on the new End-of-Life Work Group
 - o Meeting with John Nord, UDOT, to discuss aging drivers and highway design
 - o Federal Medicare/Medicaid issues
 - Most internal medicine and geriatric practices are full or nearly full
 - No board-certified geriatricians in rural communities
 - A lower than average number of geriatricians state-wide
 - Participation in the University of Utah College of Social Work Career Day
 - o Participation in Senator's Hatch's Senior Conference
 - Meetings with legislators and civic leaders
 - Results from the first Long Term Planning meeting highlighting the importance of
 - Health promotion
 - Financial responsibility
 - Improvements in the healthcare system
- The group identified the following items to consider for 2007 legislative priorities
 - o Healthcare
 - Increase Medicaid reimbursement

- Require doctors to accept no less than a certain percent of Medicare/Medicaid patients to get a license
- Find ways to retain healthcare providers who serve seniors in the State of Utah
- Renewal of the Commission on Aging
- o Education
 - Promotion of educational opportunities for older individuals
 - Promote HB 60
 - Remuneration rates
 - Tuition waiver for study in the field of aging in Utah
 - Provide part-time nursing students with financial aid
 - Provide financial aid and incentives for study of gerontology
 - Offer loan forgiveness to remain in the state and study geriatrics
 - Restore or make up funding cuts to Title 7 programs
 - Geriatric academic career award
 - Allow gerontology students to take the social work exam
- Caregiver support
 - Tax credit for family caregivers
 - Encourage Utah employers offer flexible schedules
- o Community based care
 - Increase communication and coordination between service providers
 - Provide a mechanism to help people stay in their homes, i.e. Alternatives Program
- o Financial security
 - Offer incentives for Utah employers to offer long-term care insurance
 - Tax reform
